Happy Christmas from across the Pond...

We've made the trek, and we are once again living in England, ready to begin our new mission after Christmas!

Little did we know how much change would come our way since last Christmas, but with God's fatherly care over our lives, we can always be certain that changes will be for our good. And now that we're here... I can say, YES, it's all for good! 3 days prior to Christmas 2020, Jeanann's dad, (David) went to be with Jesus, ending a 10-year run of "parent caring" in our home, for our parents. A time which can obviously have its challenges, but most definitely a time we will always "cherish." The kind of quality time that living together provides can only be rivaled by our childhood days with them, but it's so much deeper being able to share the closeness as adults.



With Dave's passing, we initiated our plan to relocate South, and landed in Blue Ridge, GA (the Blue Ridge Mountains). Little did we know, that our move to the mountains, wasn't intended to be a long-term relocation. :) In June we became clearly aware that God was speaking to us about returning to England to once again work with the Church and Organization we helped to start 25 years ago, NEW SPRINGS, UK. After a great deal of preparation, and God doing so many wonderful things to make our transition possible, we flew to England in late Nov. with our UK issued visas for "indefinite leave to remain" status, which we had hoped to once again secure. (Not an easy feat). This allowed us to be "returning residents" and simplified everything so much.

Do pray for our kids and grandkids as this means far fewer physical visits, but we are all assured that God will meet our every need on both ends!! And do pray that our house, which is now a Vacation Rental Cottage on Airbnb will turn out to become a great investment for helping us down the road. (Apparently God's plan all-along)

My role with Chi Alpha Campus Ministries (AGUSM missionary) comes to a close 12/31/21 as I begin my new role in Missions back with New Springs, UK 1/1/22. Although, we've been very active in the weekly Outreaches and Christmas time services New Springs does so well, and in a big way. It's absolutely amazing to be back working with these incredible Believers who are so passionate to reach the people of their nation. The UK/United Kingdom, made up of these 4 countries (England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland) desperately needs the Kingdom of God to be revealed in these present days! Centuries ago, known as a hub of Christianity, today after decades of decline, the percentage of Born-Again Christians is a hard thing to even gauge. Back in 1997 when we first arrived, it was estimated at only 3%. Today, I'm sorry to see that it's been declining. Just to give you a feel... approximately 4% of people attended any kind of worship service on a weekend. That was pre-Covid! Today, that's probably been halved. Of those that call themselves Born-Again, approximately 2/3 believe Jesus "Is Not the Only Way to Heaven" which sort of conflicts with His own claims. :(The need has never been greater. Pray for us as we begin this journey to recruit, envision, train, team-build, and launch new ministries throughout the U.K. as the Father leads. Praying for 10 new ministries in 10 years! **(More on back - turn over...)**



Jeanann is excited to be "setting up house" in the home we are renting soon, here in Loughborough (Luf-ber-a). We only brought 2 checked bags & 1 carry-on each. Nothing else. Although, nothing a trip to IKEA won't soon fix. So it's truly "starting over" right down to the most basic things. It is a "New Era" for us all.

Homes are smaller in the UK than in the US. This is a big home, Semi-Detached (building is shared with one other dwelling). Our place is on the left half in the red box, about 900 sq.ft. total. It's what we had previously as well. It's cozy! And cozy is good as it's already snowed twice! Last time, we only had 2 snows in 6 years.

We pray your year ahead will be full of GOOD THINGS, and you'll know the REST & PEACE of God's All-Powerful Presence, literally everyday!
